




HUNT SEAT EQUITATION

All Walk-Trot




- 1. Walk two horse lengths.
- 2. Trot right diagonal.
- 3. Sitting trot.
- 4. Stop. 270° forehand turn right.
- 5. Trot right diagonal arc.
- 6. Change diagonals in the center. Continue left diagonal.
- 7. Stop and back. 90° for ehand turn left.
- 8. Exit at sitting trot.






HUNT SEAT EQUITATION

Novice Youth, Novice Amateur




- 1. Trot right diagonal.
- $2.\ Change\ diagonals\ halfway,\ continue\ left\ diagonal\ trot.$
- 3. Sitting trot.
- 4. Stop. 270° forehand turn right.
- 5. Canter left lead arc.
- 6. Change leads. Canter right lead arc and line.
- 7. Stop and back. 90° for ehand turn left.
- 8. Walk one horse length, exit at sitting trot.






- 1. Walk two horse lengths.

- 6. Canter left lead arc.
- 7. Change leads. Canter right lead arc.
- 8. Trot right diagonal square corner.
- 9. Stop and back. Exit at sitting trot.






- 1. Walk two horse lengths.
- 2. Trot right diagonal.
- 3. Change diagonals halfway, continue left diagonal trot.
- 4. Leg yield left at the sitting trot.
- 5. Stop. 270° for ehand turn left.
- 6. Canter right lead then 2 point arc.
- 7. Change leads. Collect left lead canter.
- 8. Trot left diagonal square corner. Stop and back.
- 9. Exit at sitting trot.






- 1. Walk two horse lengths.

- 7. Sitting trot square corner.
- 8. Trot left diagonal until even with A.
- 9. Stop and back. Exit at sitting trot.


- 1. Be ready at A. Extended trot 1/3 line. Collect trot 1/3 line. Extend trot 1/3 line.
- 2. Stop. 360° left.
- 3. Lope left lead around corner.
- 4. Extended lope.
- 5. Collect lope and change leads.
- 6. Right lead lope.
- 7. Trot to pole.
- 8. Side pass right.
- 9. 360° right. Walk over poles.
- 10. Trot a "U" turn. Extended trot.
- 11. Stop. Side pass left. Stop and back. Exit at trot.






- 1. Be ready at A. Extended walk 1/4 of line.
- 2. Extended trot to pole.
- 3. Stop. Side pass right.
- 4. 450° turn right.
- 5. Lope left lead.
- 6. Change leads. Continue right lead.
- 7. Break to trot.
- 8. Lope right lead, extend the lope.
- 9. Collect lope. Stop and back at least one horse length.
- 10. Trot to poles. Walk over poles to exit.






- 1. Be ready at A. Extended trot halfway.
- 2. Lope right lead tight circle.
- 3. Extended lope around and down center.
- 4. Extended walk.
- 5. Lope left lead small circle.
- 6. Trot to and over poles.
- 7. Extended walk.
- 8. Stop and back.
- 9. 360° either way.
- 10. Exit at walk.





Youth, Youth SPB, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Amateur SPB




- 1. Trot logs around bushes.
- 2. Back "L" through hay bales.
- 3. Side pass right.
- 4. 1 1/2 turn either way.
- 5. Lope right lead over poles.
- 6. Extended lope corner, collect lope before log.
- 7. Lope over log, break to trot.
- 8. Walk over bridge into box.
- 9. Ground tie in box. Walk without horse to trailer and open door. Walk back to horse.
- 10. Walk to trailer with horse, load and unload. Lead out to exit.






RANCH TRAIL

Open, Open SPB




- 1. Trot serpentine over logs and between bushes.
- 2. Extended trot to log. Side pass right.
- 3. Lope tight right circle and over log.
- $4.\ Extended$ lope through bales of hay over log. Collect lope and stop.
- 5. Throw rope one time at hay bale and recoil rope.
- 6. 3/4 turn left. Left lead over poles.
- 7. Trot through chute and cattle pen, stop.
- 8. Back chute and extended walk into box.
- 9. Ground tie and walk without horse to trailer and open door. Walk back to horse.
- 10. Walk to trailer with horse, load and unload. Lead out to exit.






- 1. Start at A. Back at least one horse length.

- 9. Exit at the trot.






- 1. Trot 1/3 line.

- 9. 360° turn. Exit at the trot.



- 9. Exit at the extended walk.






- 1. Start at A. Back at least one horse length.

- 9. Exit at the extended walk.






TRAILYouth 13 & Under








TRAILAmateur Walk-Trot








Yearling In-Hand, SPB Yearling In-Hand, Gold Yearling In-Hand Breeders' Futurity, 2-Year-Old In-Hand








SPB Amateur Yearling In-Hand, Amateur Yearling In-Hand, Amateur 2-Year-Old In-Hand








3-Year-Old Sweepstakes, Gold Breeders' Futurity 3-Year-Old









All Walk-Trot




- 1. Extended jog square corner and line.
- 2. Stop. 90° right.
- 3. Jog two square corners.
- 4. Stop. 270° right.
- 5. Walk square corner.
- 6. Jog 2 square corners and line to A.
- 7. Stop and back at least one horse length.
- 8. Exit at the jog.






- 1. Jog half of line.

- 8. 90° turn left and exit at the walk.





Youth 13 & Under, All SPB, Bareback, Masters Amateur




- 1. Walk one horse length.

- 7. Stop and roll back on left lead.
- 8. Stop and back at least one horse length.
- 9. Exit at the jog.





Youth 18 & Under, Amateur




- 1. Walk to A. Drop stirrups.
- 2. Extended jog past center of arena.
- 3. Back at least one horse length.
- 4. 360° turn right. Pick up stirrups.
- 5. Lope left lead large fast circle.
- 6. Continue left lead lope small circle.
- 7. Change leads. Lope right lead small square.
- 8. Break to extended jog. Slow to regular jog.
- 9. Stop and hesitate. Exit at the jog.




